## POSITION SUMMARY

Off Ice Officials are qualified contractors who agree to a game schedule prior to the event, operate the score clock, and fill in the score sheet for those games accordingly, while following proper confidentiality and safety procedures and standards.

## DAILY RESPONSIBILITIES

Arrive at the arena 20-30 minute prior to each assigned game, keep score and operate the game clock properly while conducting yourself in and around the arena in a professional manner. Be at the scorers' table when the zamboni leaves the ice surface, and sound the horn if teams are not present to enter the ice at that time. Ensure the score sheet is signed by the on ice officials; distribute the back two copies to each team, and the white copy to the tournament director.
